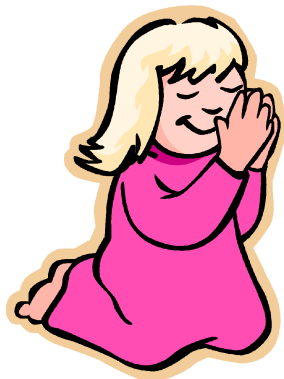
PRAYER REQUEST
